Stewart's combat experiences left him emotionally scarred, and his deepening darkness perfectly positioned him for the '50s, in which he made his greatest films, for Anthony Mann (*Winchester '73* and *Bend of the River*) and, most spectacularly, Alfred Hitchcock, in his triple meditation on marriage, *Rear Window*, *The Man Who Knew Too Much*, and *Vertigo*, which many film critics regard as the best American movie ever made. While Stewart's career thrived, so did his personal life.
