An author frequently includes subtle details or clues which hint at, or **foreshadow**, upcoming events in a novel. Foreshadowing allows an author to build a novel while laying the groundwork for upcoming character and plot development. To utilize foreshadowing, an author must plan the entire scope of a novel before he begins to write. Detailed planning allows the author to include foreshadowing throughout the novel.

Directions: Below are some examples of foreshadowing in **Beowulf**. For each example, **a.** list the details from the excerpt that indicate possible future events, **b.** write a **specific** prediction about the character or plot development that you believe is being foreshadowed, then **c.** explain **why** you believe the text foreshadows your prediction. After you finish reading the novel, you will reread your predictions to see how accurate they were. An example has been completed for you.

Ex. "The hall towered, its gables wide and high and awaiting a barbarous burning. That doom abided, but in time it would come: the killer instinct unleashed among in-laws, the blood-lust rampant." (Lines 81- 85)

- Details that may foreshadow coming events: doom, killer unleashed, blood-lust rampant
- Prediction: A bloody death or deaths will occur in Hrothgar's kingdom.
- Reason for prediction: Heorot is shown as a beautiful, glittering hall. This seems to stand in opposition to the blood-lust mentioned.
