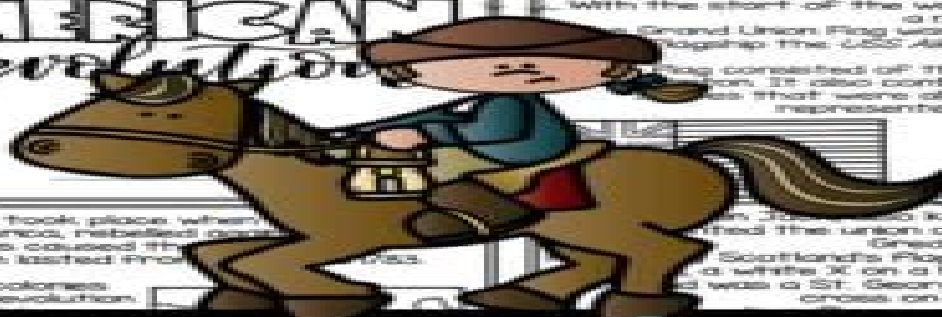




AMERICAN Revolution



The American Revolution took place when colonists that lived in America, rebelled against Great Britain. This caused the Revolutionary War, which lasted from 1775-1783.

The thirteen American colonies that participated in the revolution.

With the start of the war in 1775, the colonists wanted a new flag.

The Grand Union Flag was first flown on the US Navy's flagship the USS *Assistance* on December 3, 1775.

The flag consisted of the British Union Flag on 80% in the canton. It also contained seven red and six white stripes that were alternated. These 13 stripes represented the 13 colonies.

The flag was officially replaced by the Stars and Strips on June 14, 1777.

American Revolution Readers

MUSKET

Musket was a long-barreled weapon for the soldiers during the American Revolutionary War.

These weapons could be loaded and fired around three lead balls in one minute. As they were not very accurate, the soldiers would all fire at the same time, hoping to cover a wider area.

The 'Brown Bess' was a famous musket at the time that had a sharp blade called a bayonet, attached to the end of the gun. When an enemy came close, a soldier could fight using the blade.



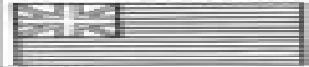
As well as wearing a uniform, which included a type of hat and carrying a gun, soldiers carried lots of other gear with them. This gear included a haversack or knapsack which works like a backpack. In this pack, they held food, clothing, a blanket, a cartridge box that contained extra ammunition and a canteen that was filled with water.

The Grand Union Flag

The Grand Union Flag was first flown on the US Navy's flagship the USS *Assistance* on December 3, 1775.

The flag consisted of the British Union Flag on 80% in the canton. It also contained seven red and six white stripes that were alternated. These 13 stripes represented the 13 colonies.

This flag was officially replaced by the Stars and Strips on June 14, 1777.



The Union Jack

The Union Jack, also known as the King's Colors, represented the union of England and Scotland into Great Britain.

Previously Scotland's flag consisted of a St. Andrew's Cross, a white X on a blue field while the flag of England was a St. George's Cross which was a red cross on a white field.

In 1707, the two flags were joined when they formed the Union.



The Battle of Bunker Hill

The Battle of Bunker Hill was one of the major battles of the American Revolution, taking place on the 17th June, 1775. It was mostly fought just north of Boston, on Bunker's Hill.

On the night of June 16, the American forces were sent to occupy Bunker Hill and prepare for battle.

The next day the British attacked, advancing twice up the hill only to retreat again. They finally took control of the hills when the American forces were forced to retreat due to running out of gun powder.

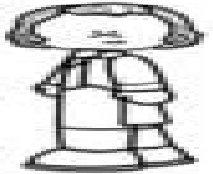
The British won the battle, though lost hundreds of soldiers with hundreds more wounded.



Thomas Jefferson was born into a wealthy family in Virginia. He studied with a tutor from the age of nine, going on to study and practice law.

When the American Revolutionary War started, he was selected as a delegate to the Second Continental Congress. It was at this time that he helped construct the Declaration of Independence.

After the war, he went on to serve as governor of Virginia and then as the third President of the United States.

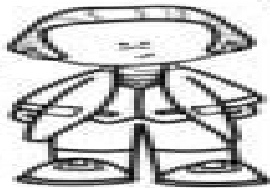


George Washington

George Washington, who became the first President of the United States, was chosen as the commanding general of the Continental Army.

With little experience, but great leadership skills, he led this army from 1775 until the end of the war.

Though he didn't win many battles, he was able to hold his army together.



After King George III declared war on the American colonists, the Continental Congress decided to declare independence from Great Britain.

As Thomas Jefferson was a gifted writer, he was asked to draft the Declaration of Independence. This document was used to explain why the 13 American colonies wanted to be free of the British rule. It also contains details on the importance of individual rights and freedoms.



The Declaration of Independence was accepted on July 4, 1776, by 12 of the American states with the new task accepted 2 days later.
