When the historical relationship uniting Sanskrit with the languages of Europe was discovered it seemed clear that Indians and Britons belonged to the same family. Thus the Indo European or Aryan idea based on the principle of linguistic kinship dominated British ethnological inquiry. In the nineteenth century however an emergent biological race science attacked the authority of the Orientalists. The spectacle of a dark skinned people who were evidently civilized challenged Victorian ideas and race science responded to the enigma of India by redefining the Aryan concept in narrowly white racial terms. By the end of the nineteenth century race science and Orientalism reached a deep and lasting consensus in regard to India which Trautmann calls the racial theory of Indian civilization and which he undermines with his powerful analysis of colonial ethnology in India. His work of reassessing British Orientalism and the Aryan idea will be of great interest to historians anthropologists and cultural critics.
