Democracy and Public Space Aug 14 2022 In an online, interconnected

world, democracy is increasingly made up of wikis and blogs, pokes and tweets. This can be seen not just in the way that traditional protest is regulated, but in the ways that ordinary city streets and parks are managed, even in the design of such quintessentially democratic spaces as legislative assemblies. The book offers an alternative vision for democratic public space, and evaluates 11 cities - from London to Tokyo - against that ideal.
