There was only so much Howard could do in Solomon Kane's world. Moreover, Solomon Kane is just a hard character to root for. Unlike Kull, he is not too fine a point on it; really, not a sane man. So it makes perfect sense that after the shadowy prehistoric world of Kull and the dark necromantic world of Solomon Kane, Howard would combine these two precursors to develop a world that was far enough into the distant past to be free of actual historical constraints like Kull's, yet close enough to the present to still exist as echoes and legends in the world's mythologies.
