At one end, there are tales of woe: how the original inhabitants of the region are being evicted from their land through violence and trickery, their marginalization and elimination of their traditional way of life simultaneously, while it is being exoticized for tourism. These accounts, however, paint a static picture where the members of these ethnic groups are
