Block grants have surprisingly large positive effects on public expenditures. Researchers have attributed this "flypaper effect" to imperfect information (fiscal illusion), bureaucratic self-interest (Leviathan motives), and flawed econometrics. In this paper, a three-sector, computable general equilibrium model of a local economy is used to explore the effects of block grants and matching grants. However, relatively more grants were transferred from the central government to the poor states than to their rich counterparts. Significant barriers to population flows also exist, as net migration from poor to rich states responded only weakly to cross-state income differentials.

associated with grant writing will prove helpful as you work with funders who represent individual foundations and corporations. The Appendix also contains a published article on "Funding Your Ministry Through Grants" that was published online for www.childrensministry.com/readers. Additional space provides pages for notes as you research grants to fund your project. In your search, identify the gap in what your organization has and what it needs to run an effective program. Where is the gap? How can a funder fulfill that gap? And then, match the need to the funder. When you've answered these questions, you're on your way to securing funds for specific needs.
