INTRODUCTION

Massage therapists are a part of a broad community of allied health-care providers. Member groups within this community develop and maintain specific research agendas and strategic plans to guide the development of the knowledge base that serves as the foundation of practice for their profession.⁽¹⁻³⁾

The Massage Therapy Foundation (MTF) is a primary steward of massage therapy research, funding studies to advance the science and art of massage therapy over the past 30 years. The first massage therapy research agenda was developed by the MTF in 1991 and outlined five key goals: 1) Build a research infrastructure within the massage therapy profession; 2) Fund research into the safety and efficacy of massage therapy; 3) Fund studies on physiological and other mechanisms by which massage therapy achieves its effects; 4) Fund studies stemming from a wellness paradigm; and 5) Fund studies on the profession of therapeutic massage. This effort, combined with the efforts of international massage organizations⁽⁴⁾ facilitated the growth and development of the massage therapy profession in each of the goal areas, and greatly expanded the knowledge base that now supports the science-informed practice of therapeutic massage.

The MTF evaluated the extensive progress and remaining knowledge gaps, then put together a team to develop a new research agenda to guide and advance the therapeutic massage knowledge base into the future.

Process Description

The MTF 2020 Massage Therapy Research Agenda was developed by a team of experienced researchers, massage therapists, business owners, administrators, educators, and other allied health-care providers. The agenda was also developed to align with the United States National Institutes of Health's National Center for Complementary and Integrative Health (NCCIH) Strategic Framework,⁽⁵⁾ presenting a unified strategy for advancing the profession.

The MTF 2020 Massage Therapy Research Agenda

The MTF 2020 Massage Therapy Research Agenda has four key objectives, each with specific goals (Figure 1). The agenda aspires to support the work of every member of the massage therapy community. Following each objective is a section called "Moving the Agenda Forward", with a few ideas on how researchers, practitioners, educators, students, and organizations can become involved in progressing the agenda and the profession.

Objective 1: Advance Fundamental Science and Methods Development

Goals:

1. Advance understanding of basic biological mechanisms of action of therapeutic massage and bodywork in the management of chronic and acute conditions.

Hixson,2006-03-15 Women experience sexual and domestic violence at alarmingly high rates Recovery from this type of trauma can be a complex and extensive process that in best cases involves a broad network for support This dissertation examined the experiences of women over the age of 21 who have received massage therapy during their healing process from sexual or domestic violence For the purposes of this study the women who participated were often referred to as survivors of abuse Current research examined in the literature review indicates that the effects of this type of trauma are multifaceted and that one of the interventions sought for diminishing the effects of this trauma is massage The importance of this study completed with the use of descriptive research methodology included the opportunity to gain information from abuse survivors about their personal experiences with massage and how they can best be served by the massage therapist The results of a self report survey and interview process provide valuable information to raise awareness of these societal issues among massage professionals While the subjects were not interviewed about their specific experiences of abuse they provided important information about the effects that these experiences have had on their lives Further the women interviewed shared information about the concerns that they had with regard to massage therapy and some of the specific experiences that they have had during massage sessions Although the sample size was small with 10 women interviewed the information provided has clear implications for the practice of massage therapy Some of the implications found involve therapist gender trust building between client and practitioner and communication with the client during massage therapy sessions Recommendations for massage professionals have been made based on these findings Further research

Moyer,2003 [Factors Related to Satisfaction, Pain and Affect Outcomes in Massage Therapy Clients](#) Karen Therese Boulanger,2012 Massage therapy is often used to treat musculoskeletal symptoms and to promote wellness While evidence regarding its effectiveness is increasing research related to actual practice and studies seeking to understand the mechanisms of massage therapy are needed The purpose of this research was to describe the characteristics of massage therapists and their clients and to understand the role of communication in massage therapy outcomes The first study examined the outcome expectations expectancies and behaviors of a random sample of massage therapists in Iowa n 151 using a cross sectional survey The second study used a practice based research design incorporating two samples of massage therapy clients n 320 and n 321 to develop and validate a measure of client expectations of massage the Client Expectations of Massage Scale CEMS The third study examined the influence of client expectations and massage therapists interpersonal attractiveness on pain and satisfaction following massage Social Cognitive Theory and Expectancy

Violation Theory were used as frameworks to demonstrate how health behavior and communication theories can provide insight to massage therapy research Results indicated that massage therapists had high expectations regarding the benefits of massage therapy and engaged in a variety of behaviors that reflect the clinical educational and interpersonal nature of massage therapy In addition to using a variety of manual therapies the massage therapists educated their clients in areas such as diet stress management and exercise to improve client health Similarly clients had positive expectations as measured by the outcome clinical educational and interpersonal subscales of the CEMS Positive outcome expectations predicted significant improvements in pain and serenity High interpersonal expectations were related to negative changes in serenity The third study revealed that high satisfaction was influenced by positive interpersonal attractiveness but more research is needed to understand the influence of client expectations being met on satisfaction Initially high educational expectations exceeded educational expectations violated interpersonal expectations and positive interpersonal attractiveness were related to less pain following massage In conclusion this research demonstrated that client expectations and massage therapist interpersonal attractiveness are important constructs to consider when evaluating the effects of massage therapy
