We never know how long we have with the people we love, but even when they're gone, the people we love have a way of staying with us. This book is an ode to "The Man", from the son who lost him, and through memories and love, found him again. Lea crash-lands her shot-up scout ship on Pamaar—a planet that shouldn't be there.
