The Holocaust was the systematic, bureaucratic, state-sponsored persecution and murder of six million Jews by the Nazi regime and its collaborators.

a. Pagan is a Roman word meaning "to worship nature, to celebrate fertility."
b. Historically, the term refers to explicit articles by Nazi leadership publications on Jews in the Eastern Europe and in other countries.
5. Define GENOCIDE. How did the word come into existence?

a. The term genocide did not exist before 1948. It is a very specific term, referring to intent crimes committed against groups with the intent to destroy, in whole or in part, the existence of the group.
b. In 1948, a team of Jewish survivors named Raphael Lemkin (1900-1959) sought to describe the Nazi process of systematic murder, including the destruction of the European Jews, in formalized the word "genocide" by combining geno-, from the Greek word for race or tribe, with -cide, derived from the Latin word for killing. In proposing the new term, Lemkin had in mind the established practice of eliminating entire villages of the destruction of specific heritages of the life of national groups, with the aim of annihilating the group themselves. The next year, the International Military Tribunal, Tribunal held at Nuremberg, Germany, charged the Nazis with crimes against humanity. The word genocide was included in the indictment, but as a descriptive, not legal term.
6. What were GHETTOS? Why did the Nazis establish them?

a. The term ghetto originated from the name of the Jewish quarter in Venice, established in 1516, which the Venetian authorities segregated the city's Jews to live. During World War II, ghettos were city districts often enclosed in walls the Germans concentrated the municipal and commercial Jewish population and forced them to live under miserable conditions. Ghettos isolated Jews by separating Jewish communities from the non-Jewish population and from other Jewish communities.
b. The Germans regarded the establishment of ghettos as a provisional measure to control and segregate Jews within the Nazi territory. Their established goal was to realize the goal of eradicating the Jewish population.
