Wickham, commander of the famous 101st Airborne Division in the 1970s and subsequently Army Chief of Staff, once visited Antietam battlefield. And they fought to defend their honor and manhood. 'I should not like to go home with the name of a coward,' one Massachusetts private wrote, and another private from Ohio said, 'My wife would sooner hear of my death than my disgrace.' Even after three years of bloody battles, more than half of the Union soldiers reenlisted voluntarily. 'While duty calls me here and my country demands my services, I should be willing to make the sacrifice,' one man wrote to his protesting parents. And another soldier said simply, 'I still love my country.' McPherson draws on more than 25,000 letters and nearly 250 private diaries from men on both sides. Civil War soldiers were among the most literate soldiers in history, and most of them wrote home frequently as it was the only way for them to keep in touch with homes that many of them had left for the first time in their lives.
