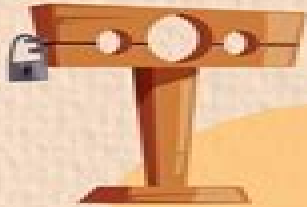
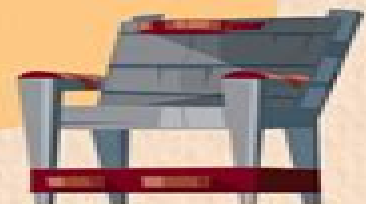
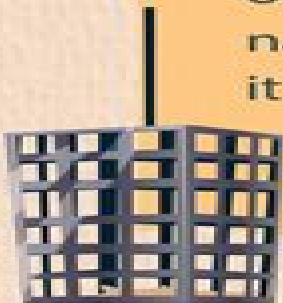


Death Penalty
