→ **Anatomy & Physiology Defined *2** (* = page #'s in Marieb text)

Anatomy is the study of the **structures** of the body and body parts and

Physiology is the study of the **functions** of the body and body parts.

→ **Define Anatomical Position *11**

Standing in anatomical position is similar to "standing at attention".

The body is erect with the feet parallel and the arms hanging at the sides with the palms facing, eyes, and toes all facing the **anterior (ventral)** surface.

→ **10 Directional Terms *11 and 12**

In anatomical position, the gluteal region and scapular regions are on the **dorsal/posterior** body surface. The top of the head is the most **superior** part of the body. The ears are **medial (or superior)** to the shoulders and **lateral** to the nose.

The heart is **deep** to the skeleton. The elbow is **proximal** to the fingers, but **distal** to the shoulder. The sternum is **medial (or inferior)** to the shoulder.

→ **4 Body Planes *15**

If an incision cuts the heart into right and left parts, the section is a **sagittal** section, but if the heart is cut so that anterior and posterior parts result, the section is **frontal**.

In the body portraits the top half of the body was separate from the lower

half of the body. These two portions of the body were separated by a **transverse** plane.
