It clarifies for the new gatherers where and how a new diversity of religious congregations is in the process of being established. Finally, the book

covers two important topical issues: pluralisation and secularisation. It provides new data on religious diversity, painting a new picture of secularisation: the impact and structural consequences of the long-term decrease of membership in the established churches.
