## Lambda Expressions

Lambda expressions are a concise way to represent anonymous functions in Java.

They provide a shorthand notation for writing code by allowing the creation of small, inline implementations of functional interfaces.

Lambda expressions consist of parameters, an arrow token (`->`), and a body.

// Ensures the interface can have just one method
@FunctionalInterface
interface SumFunction {
    int sum(int a, int b);
}

public class LambdaExample {

    public static void main(String[] args) {
        SumFunction sumFunction = (a, b) -> a + b;
        int result = sumFunction.sum(3, 3);
    }
}
```

Functional interfaces are Java interfaces that contain exactly one abstract method. They serve as the foundation for Lambda expressions.

## The world before Lambda

This is the same example rewritten as a standard anonymous inner class:

```
interface SumFunction {
    int sum(int a, int b);
}

SumFunction sumFunction = new SumFunction() {
    @Override
    public int sum(int a, int b) {
        return a + b;
    }
};

int result = sumFunction.sum(3, 3);
```

All functional interfaces implement exactly one method, which allows for syntactic sugar to implement that one method with much less code.
