stark contrast to the risk for mothers in America, where it's one in 4,800 or in Ireland, where it's just one in 48,000.

Addressing that gap is a multidisciplinary challenge,

requiring an emphasis on education, human resources, community involvement and social equality. At a minimum, women must be guaranteed antenatal care, skilled birth attendants and emergency obstetrics, and postpartum care. These essential interventions will only be guaranteed within the context of improved education and the abolition of discrimination.
