Germ Theory and Its Applications to Medicine & on the Antiseptic Principle of the Practice of Surgery Louis Pasteur, 1996 Before the introduction of antisepsis and inoculation people commonly died due to unsanitary conditions in the home or following surgery or childbirth Between them the great scientists Louis Pasteur 1822 1893 and Joseph Lister 1827 1912 extended widely the practice of inoculation and revolutionized medical practice Pasteur's discovery that living organisms are the cause of fermentation formed the basis of the modern germ theory Following Pasteur's researches Lister proceeded to develop his antiseptic surgical methods. These breakthroughs in medicine are to be reckoned among the greatest discoveries of the nineteenth century The Principia Sir Isaac Newton, 2010-12-29 Sir Isaac Newton's Principia Mathematica Mathematical Principles is considered to be among the finest scientific works ever published His grand unifying idea of gravitation with effects extending throughout the solar system explains by one principle such diverse phenomena as the tides the precession of the equinoxes and the irregularities of the moon's motion Newton's brilliant and revolutionary contributions to science explained the workings of a large part of inanimate nature mathematically and suggested that the remainder might be understood in a similar fashion By taking known facts forming a theory that explained them in mathematical terms deducing consequences from the theory and comparing the results with observed and experimental facts Newton united for the first time the explication of physical phenomena with the means of prediction By beginning with the physical axioms of the laws of motion and gravitation he converted physics from a mere science of explanation into a general The Origin of Species Charles Darwin, Since its publication in 1859 The Origin of Species has mathematical system been the focal point of debate Darwin's analysis of flora and fauna calls into question the long held concepts of spontaneous generation divine creation and the unrelatedness of many species Instead he argues for Natural Selection species survive and evolve in response to environmental conditions and other circumstances through a process in which those creatures and plants with stronger more enduring characteristics live to beget more adaptable offspring It was Darwin's research aboard the H M S Beagle that led to the clash of intellectual titans religion and science over the true nature of humankind Here is the book that started one of the greatest debates of the Western world The Elements of Natural Philosophy William Thomson, One of the most celebrated scientists of the 19th century William Thomson Lord Kelvin was said to have more letters after his name than any man in the British Empire His prodigious accomplishments included both theoretical insights and significant inventions Among his contributions to theory were advances in hydrodynamics an innovative synthesis of the mathematical relationship between electricity and heat and major work in the second law of thermodynamics In the practical

realm he created the absolute temperature scale which bears his name worked on the development of the first transatlantic telegraph cable and invented a telegraph receiver a compass adopted by the British Admiralty a form of analog computer for measuring tides and sounding equipment Always in the forefront of the leading scientists of the day he collaborated with James Clerk Maxwell Hermann von Helmholtz James Prescott Joule and Peter Guthrie Tait The Elements of Natural Philosophy was done with Tait a pioneering physicist and mathematician whose work in advanced algebra formed the basis of vector analysis and was instrumental in the later development of modern mathematical physics. An abridgement of their original Treatise on Natural Philosophy this work was designed to be accessible to students with a basic knowledge of algebra geometry and trigonometry As such it is a book that nonspecialists can still appreciate Like Isaac Newton's great summation of natural philosophy in the late 17th century The Principia Mathematica this work remains of interest to historians of science because it represented a similar summation of the grand synthesis that scientists building upon Newton s work envisioned at the end of the 19th century Not long after its publication however was the advent of relativity and quantum physics which considerably changed and enlarged the picture of the natural world as conceived by earlier generations of scientists Encyclopedia of Pestilence, Pandemics, and Plaques [2 volumes] Joseph P.
