● a literary device used to *directly* compare things

● states that one thing *is* another thing

## Examples

- The unplanned renovation *is* a disaster waiting to happen.
- We are a fleeting speck of dust.
- Everyday with you *is* a fairytale.

● a literary device used to make *explicit* comparisons

● uses the words "*as*" and "*like*" to compare things

● all similes are metaphors, but not all metaphors are similes.

## Examples

- His room *is like* a disaster area.
- Forgetting her is *as hard as* remembering a stranger.
- Our wedding was *like* a fairytale.
